The Water Institute Graduate Student Affiliate Program

Application - Fall 2021

I. General Information

The Water Institute Graduate Student Affiliate program is designed to assist Master's and Ph.D. students working on water resource research. The affiliate program will provide tuition and fees for the students as well as compensation for their 20 hours per week work with the Water Institute.

II. Eligibility and Award Terms

Any currently enrolled Ph.D. or Master's students at the University of Idaho that are working on an aspect of water resources research may apply to the graduate student affiliate program.

Requirements include that the students must;

- be a Graduate student (Preferably Ph.D. student) at the University of Idaho,
- maintain at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA,
- be studying a discipline within water resources (broadly defined) and
- agree to complete a 20 hours per week of work with the Water Institute.

The successful applicants will be chosen based upon a written application as well as an onsite interview.

III. Selection Process and Notification

Immediately after the **May 1, 2020** deadline the applications will be screened by the Water Institute staff. Interviews then will be scheduled and held with a subset of the applicant pool before **May 10, 2020**. The Water Institute will notify all applicants of the final decision on **May 14, 2020** after all interviews are completed. Applicants will be notified of decisions via email. Should you be selected you will need to accept the offer and return the offer letter signed by you and your major professor before **May 19, 2020**.

Disclaimer: The Water Institute will not return submitted materials. Incomplete or incorrectly completed applications will be rejected without further review.
