3+3 LAW DEGREE PROGRAM:

Accelerated program to earn your bachelor and juris doctor degrees in six (6) years

In conjunction with the University of Idaho and other participating colleges and universities (listed on reverse), the College of Law offers an accelerated track to earn your bachelor and juris doctor degrees in six years through the 3+3 program.

Eligible students must have an LSAT score and a cumulative GPA at or above the College of Law's median scores. Students need to take the LSAT no later than fall (Aug - Nov) of the student's junior year, so plan ahead and take the LSAT early.

Upon completion of credits that comprise the student's full third year of undergraduate studies, 3+3 program students will begin the first year at the College of Law to simultaneously complete their 1L year and their bachelor's degree.

IMPORTANT DATES

SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Meet with your advisor
- Submit 3+3 Program registration form to advisor in a timely manner

SUMMER FOLLOWING SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Make plans to take the LSAT no later than December of your junior year.

JUNIOR YEAR

- Register and take the LSAT no later than December (if applicable)
- Apply for admission no later than January 15th
- Provide certification letter that shows 97 completed semester hours (146 quarter hours) prior to entering the College of Law
- After student is accepted, submit 3+3 Law Program Course Substitution Form

WHAT ARE THE 3+3 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS?

- Meet with an advisor as soon as possible. The advisor will confer with the College of Law Admissions Office to determine if the student's major is appropriate for the 3+3 Program.
- A verification letter is due at the time of application from the department chair that the student will receive a bachelor's degree upon the successful completion of the first year of law school.
