HOW TO REPORT BIAS AND HATE CRIMES IN IDAHO

WHAT IS A HATE CRIME?

Hate crimes are outlawed by both the federal government and the State of Idaho.

Idaho law states that "it is the right of every person regardless of <u>race</u>, <u>color</u>, <u>ancestry</u>, <u>religion or national origin</u>, to be secure and protected from fear, intimidation, harassment, and physical harm caused by the activities of groups and individuals." I.C. § 18-7901. The state law protects people from physical harm, harm to property, and threats of physical harm or harm to property because of that person's race, color, religion, ancestry, or national origin. I.C. § 18-7902. The crime includes placing any word or symbol commonly associated with racial, religious or ethnic terrorism on the property of another person without his or her permission.

Federal law protects individuals from bodily injury or an attempt to cause bodily injury, through the use of a weapon because of the person's actual or perceived <u>race</u>, <u>color</u>, <u>religion</u>, <u>or national origin</u>, <u>gender</u>, <u>sexual orientation</u>, <u>gender identity</u>, <u>or disability</u>. 18 U.S.C. § 249. This U.S. law does not cover harm to property or threats. Another U.S. law protects individuals from injury or threats of injury based on race, color, religion, or national origin tied to specific activities such as voting, attending public school, and working. 18 U.S.C. § 245.

DO I HAVE TO BE A U.S. CITIZEN TO REPORT A HATE CRIME?

No. The U.S. Attorney's office, the FBI, the county prosecutors, and the local police will respond to reports of hate crimes regardless of your citizenship.

HOW DO I REPORT AN INCIDENT?

You have several options for reporting a potential crime: (See next page for contact information.)

- call your local police department,
- the county prosecutor's office,

- the FBI in Boise, or
- the U.S. Attorney's Office in Boise.

Make a report by phone and in writing. You can call more than one office to seek a response. Even if the incident is not serious enough to be a crime, reporting it helps officials respond if something happens again.

WHEN SHOULD I REPORT AN INCIDENT?

The sooner the better to allow officials to investigate, but you can still call and report an incident that happened weeks ago.

WHAT INFORMATION WILL I NEED TO PROVIDE?

If you can do it safely, make video or audio recordings and take pictures. Write down what happened, where it happened, and when it happened. Get the names and contact information for any witnesses.

CAN I HAVE A LAWYER, PARENT, OR FRIEND WITH ME?

Yes. The official responding to the information may need to speak directly with you but you can have someone with you to help explain what happened and provide support.

WHAT IF THE INCIDENT HAPPENED AT A SCHOOL, JAIL, OR HOSPITAL?

If you are in a public school, file a formal grievance. Look on your school district or college website for grievance and civil rights policies. Ask jail officials or hospital employees for their grievance procedure and file a report.
