### **Explanation of Estimated Expenses:**

- Room and board expenses reflect the average cost of living on or off campus in Idaho.
- Books and supplies expenses are based on average costs for a full-time student for 1 academic year.
- Personal expenses include items such as clothing, transportation, special course fees, personal care products, etc.
- Summer expenses are based upon full-time summer enrollment, which is 12 credits for undergraduates and 9 credits for graduate students.

### **Reminders:**

- Spouses with F-2 visa status are not permitted to work under any circumstances. Spouses may apply for work permission only if they have J-2 visa status.
- You are responsible for all costs. Students are ultimately responsible for securing all financial resources. In the event that a private sponsor, government agency or other funding source is delinquent with financial support, the student is held responsible. Registration may be blocked and housing contracts, transcripts, diplomas, and I-20s or DS-2019s are not issued for individuals who owe money to the University of Idaho.
- **To get a visa and/or enter the U.S**. All financial documentation you submit may need to be presented to the US Consular official when you apply for your visa and may be requested upon entry into the U.S. It is recommended to include documentation of your financial plan for the full length of your academic program.
