1. 15ft "circuit protected" Power strip

2. Multi-plug "circuit protected"

3. "Squid" "circuit protected"

- Replace extension cords being used on a permanent basis with "circuit protected" power strips with cords long enough to plug directly into an outlet.
- 2. Multi-plugs must be "circuit protected".
- 3. "Squids" allow room to plug in multiple Power Adapters.
- 4. Outlets within six feet of sinks or other water sources must be Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protected.
- 5. GFCI circuit breakers installed by a qualified electrician may be used to provide GFCI protection in multiple locations on the same circuit.
