Oil Painting Requirements: Unit II

PURPOSE:

- 1. To learn how to mix oil colors, texture and application of oils.
- 2. To learn how to use a palette knife, thinner and medium.
- 3. To learn how strokes and texture can be created with different ways of application (brushes, palette knives, sponges, etc.)
- 4. To learn how to use and care for the different brushes.
- 5. To learn transparent and opaque colors.
- 6. To learn how to pull a painting together and paint a picture to be proud of.
- 7. To learn how to properly frame your painting.

REQUIREMENTS UNIT II: (Include information learned in your story in the ZSuite 4-H Record Book.)

- 1. Correctly sketch the picture you desire to paint and exhibit it at the fair.
- 2. Study colors. Learn what happens when different colors are mixed.
- 3. Take a field trip and study nature.
- 4. Visit an art museum or study about art and oil paintings.
- 5. Learn about transparent and opaque colors, also medium and whites.
- 6. Learn what different brushes can do and how to care for them.
- 7. Learn about palette knives and painting surfaces, (canvasses.).
- 8. Paint at least two oil paintings no larger than 18"x24".
- 9. Learn how to frame and preserve your paintings.
