Kendall Memorial 4-H/FFA Scholarship Guidelines

General Recommendations:

The Kendall Memorial Scholarship application must be sent to the local County Extension staff with 4-H responsibilities. Scholarship applications must be typed, include a cover page, and include a photo of applicant. You are able to fill out on -line, however for judging purposes, you must print application out.

Qualifications for the Scholarship:

- 1. Applicant must have been an active Gem/Boise County member of 4-H &/or FFA for a minimum of 2 years. In addition, membership in other counties may be included
- 2. Preference given to agriculture students, but not restricted to ag students.
- 3. Applicant must be in senior year of high school and completed requirements for high school graduation or currently in college or vocational school.
- 4. Applicant must submit one (1) letter of recommendation.
- 5. Recommended that recipient have taken a minimum of 3 years of livestock projects.
- 6. Scholarship can be won only once.

Selection:

Previous Scholarship winners will be ineligible to reapply. Applications will be judged by the Kendall family or family Designee.

Award:

The amount of the award will vary depending upon rate of interest earned prior to the presentation year.

How to receive award:

- Recipient must send a letter of thanks to the award donor.
- In order to receive the scholarship money, the recipient must send a copy of their admission letter or class schedule to the Extension office or the Kendall family at.
