This \$500 scholarship is available to active Gem/Boise County 4-H members who:

- 1) were seniors in high school during the current 4-H year or
- are currently enrolled in college and have remained active in 4-H in a leadership position.

It is to be used for further education at the college or university level.

The recipient must have been an active 4-H member, completing 4-H projects and/or activities each year of their entire high school career.

Giving back to the 4-H Club:

The 4-H member must have enrolled in and completed a 4-H Leadership project within the last two years of their 4-H career. The recipient may be a 4-H Ambassador (this would certainly be considered an advantage), but does not substitute for completing a Leadership project.

Giving back to the Community:

The recipient of this scholarship must show proof of participation in 4-H Record Book Portfolio of 4-H community service projects for the last two years of their 4-H career.

4-H Projects:

The recipient should be an individual who has broadened their knowledge base by:

- 1) Completing many projects or
- 2) Focusing on one project area and exploring many avenues and facets of that project.

Either way, the individual should show both growth and progress during their 4-H career, not simply in project work, but by becoming involved beyond the club level.

Selection is made by the Extension Educators based on the 4-Her's portfolio, Involvement Report and 4-H records and subjective knowledge of the individual.

An application is available at the Extension Office, and must be returned to the Gem County Extension Office by September 11th. This scholarship will be awarded at Recognition Night. Please call 365-6363 with any questions.
