FINAL ANIMAL CHECK-IN / WEIGH-IN: Please enter the fairgrounds by the Sand Arena off Hwy 16, continue on behind the bucking chutes to the scales and exiting onto Johns Avenue. Do Not Park On Track. Animal feed and equipment needed for Fair may be dropped off at the fairgrounds beginning Saturday, July 27 and any time other than weigh-in times listed above. During weigh-ins, drivers are to stay in vehicles; if a member needs assistance, please make arrangement beforehand with club leader and/or Superintendents.

- \* Animals brought to fair must be on official fair entry form.
- \* Animals being checked in for Fair must be clean and "show ready" for Vet Check.
- \*\* Animals that do not make the minimum weights may be entered in the feeder class or taken home.
- \*\*\* Lambs must be slick shorn prior to initial weigh-in (shearing available at weigh-in for small fee) AND at least 10 days prior to final weigh-in.

Swine trailers must be clean before coming to weigh-in.

Fitting of ALL animals MUST be done by members, NOT by parents, leaders, or other persons. Penalties may be exercised for this violation. Parents, leaders, and other adults may give advice and direction, but not do the work of clipping, washing, etc. in fitting animals for the show.

All Fair Entries must be submitted prior to July 5th and must have started their project records and involvement reports in order to be approved. Check for email communication in May for specific instructions on completing entries and Portfolios.
