The primary objective of the Hippology contest is to provide, in a friendly but competitive setting, an opportunity for youth enrolled in 4-H to demonstrate the breadth of their knowledge and understanding of equine science and management, and in particular, the practical application of this knowledge and skill. It is hoped that this contest will generate new friendships and be a rewarding experience for the contestants

A. Eligibility

1. Must be a current Kootenai/Shoshone 4-H member.
2. Age divisions will be determined by contestant's age as of January 1st (by oldest contestant's age in team/ensemble presentations):

- Juniors 8 - 10 years
- Intermediates 11 - 13 years
- Seniors 14 - 18 years

B. Contest Rules

1. Contestants may enter no more than 3 presentations. Each presentation must be unique.
2. Contest categories are:
 - Demonstrations / Illustrated Talks
 - Speeches
 - Dramatic Presentations

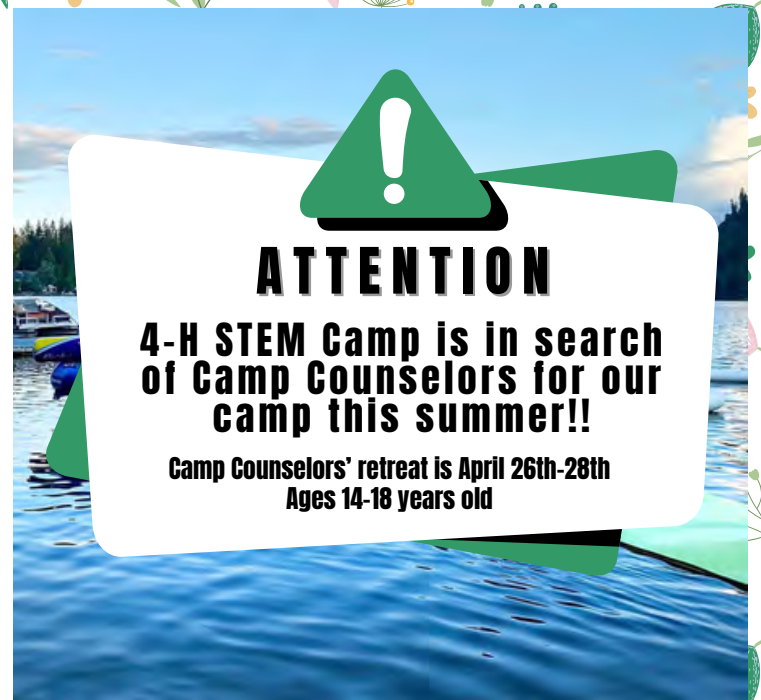
