## Cat & Dog Shows

Wednesday, August 2 & 9, 2023 Cat – 6:00pm; Dog – 5:00pm LATAH COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Registration will be in ZSuite Events!

Arrive 30 minutes before the show to check-in. Keep your animal on a leash and under control at all times.

Clean up after your animal and bring a water and food dish. Animals must be current on vaccinations to show.

#### **Fundraising Opportunity!**

The USA Dry Pea & Lentil Council is looking for assistance with bagging lentil samples. The USADPLC needs approximately 3,000 bags of lentils that will be distributed for marketing purposes. This is an opportunity for your 4-H club to make some money!

At least one adult must attend with the group to supervise. Each member under 8 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

4-H members will come to the USADPLC office to complete the project. There is a large workroom where ALL SUPPLIES NECESSARY WILL BE PROVIDED. USADPLC office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Depending on the number of members working, 1,000 bags can be done in 2-3 hours. This is an easy job and can be completed fairly quickly depending on the number of workers.

- A USADPLC staff member will demonstrate the process and be available to answer questions on site.
- Each "sample bag" gets a recipe card placed inside, a corresponding label on the outside, and 1 cup of the specified pulse poured into the bag.
- After the lentils and recipe card have been placed inside, the bag gets zipped and placed in a corresponding box.
- The club will be responsible for cleanup before leaving the office.

The deadline for completion is July 31, 2023.

For every 1,000 bags of lentils completed, your club will be paid \$150. A check will be mailed to the club following completion.


