The Involvement Report is a <u>required</u> part of the record book that carries forward each year. Each section must be completed & included in the record book, even if information is not applicable, in which case the field should be filled with "None" or N/A".

Tab - 4-H Story

Members write about their total 4-H experience, utilizing the "Total Experience" option in ZSuite.

- Juniors (8- to 10-year-olds) 1 to 4 pages
- Intermediates (11- to 13-year-olds) 2 to 6 pages
- Seniors (14 to 18-year-olds) 3 to 8 page
