

## Web Registration – Hints and Tips

1. Open a web-browser (MS Internet Explorer).
2. Go to <http://www.uidaho.edu/registration>.
3. Enter the requested info and click on “Login” button.
4. Follow links “Student Information/Registration Menu” > “Registration Menu” and then to “Add/Drop Classes”. *This is the registration page!*
5. Open another window (or TAB) to the web-page <http://www.uidaho.edu/schedule/>
6. Select “All courses” under the Fall 2008 title. *This will take you to the class schedule.*
7. By selecting a department (e.g. CE) in the left-pane, the right-pane will display the classes offered by the department. This will show the meeting time, number of credits and most importantly, the CRN # in the left column.  

For example, the CRN # for section 01 of CE 115, is “16348”.
8. Now you may cut and paste the CRN # from one browser to the other browser window with the registration info.
9. To register, click the “Submit” button. *Click this button often, preferably after entering the CRN# for each class!*
10. You may also review your “Time Schedule” with the link at the base of the registration page.

## Typical Classes for Civil Engineering Freshman Year

- CE 115, Introduction to Civil Engineering (2 cr)
- Chem 111, Principles of Chemistry I (4 cr)
- Core 103-129 and 153-170 (4 cr in the Fall + 3 cr in the Spring)
- Engl 102, College Writing and Rhetoric (3 cr)
- Engr 105, Engineering Graphics (2 cr)
- Phys 211, Engineering Physics I (3 cr) – *Lab is recommended, but not required!*
- Math 170, 175, Analytic Geometry and Calculus (8 cr)
- Phil 103, Ethics (3 cr)
- Econ 201 or 202, or 272, Principles of Economics (3-4 cr)
- Basic Science Electives, select two of the following (8-9 cr):
  - Biol 115 Cells and the Evolution of Life (4 cr)
  - Chem 112 Principles of Chemistry II (5 cr), **or**  
Phys 212, 212L Engineering Physics II and Lab (4 cr)
  - Geol 111, 111L Physical Geology for Science Majors and Lab (4 cr) – **FALL ONLY**
  - MMBB 154, 155 Introductory Microbiology and Lab (4 cr) – **SPRING ONLY**

**Possible Prerequisite Classes:** Chem 050; Engl 090, 101; Math 108, Math 143
