### **NOTES & REQUIREMENTS**

- A minimum of 120 credits are required for a B.S.
- 36 of the 120 cr. must be upper-division (300-400 level). All credits from NIC are considered lower div.
- 30 of your upper division credits must be from UI
- You must complete your psych courses with a grade of "C" or better & an institutional gpa of 2.5
