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<p><b>NOTES &amp; REQUIREMENTS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students planning on transferring to UI are advised to complete an <i>Associate of Science</i> degree at NIC.</li> <li>- Students can be concurrently enrolled (NIC and UI) while completing an NIC degree</li> <li>- NIC students may transfer up to 70 credits to UI</li> <li>- Check w/ UI adviser for potential substitutions</li> </ul>	<p><b>NOTES &amp; REQUIREMENTS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 120 credits are required for a B.S. (this includes up to 70 of your NIC credits)</li> <li>- 30 of your upper division credits must be from UI</li> <li>- A minimum 2.75 gpa is required for graduation</li> </ul>
