

IDAHO TREASURE AWARD

PURPOSE

Recognizes living retired University of Idaho faculty, staff and family members who, in their retirement years, have made significant achievements in service or leadership to the university.

ESTABLISHED 1995

CRITERIA

1. Volunteer service to the University of Idaho and campus; including but not limited to colleges, departments, alumni groups, student organizations, living groups or campus service groups.
2. Community and civic service may be considered in the evaluation, but is scored as secondary to "university and campus service."
3. Nominees must have been retired from full-time University of Idaho employment for a period of five years or more to be eligible for nomination.

PROCESS

Include the following data with nominations:

- Letters of support or reference (2-5 submissions) that detail the nominees "achievements in service or leadership to the university."
- Media or web references are helpful, but not required, to support the nomination.

Couples nominated should include the individual service record of each living person. Attach additional sheets detailing specific accomplishments of nominee.

PROCEDURE

Application Deadline: Nomination form must be returned to Alumni Office prior to April

1. Nomination form must be complete and thorough. This information is the basis for the evaluation of the candidate.

(Note: Nominations may not be submitted for persons currently holding or running for state or national political office.)

Review Body: Members of the University of Idaho Retirees Association Awards Committee shall review all complete award nominations.

The UIRA Awards Committee shall recommend candidates to the Retirees Association Board of Directors. The Retirees Association Board of Directors shall review and approve, or disapprove, recommended candidates. The Alumni Association does not review or screen Idaho Treasure Award nominations, but supports the process to recognize deserving candidates.

Nominee Review and Consideration: Candidates with completed nomination forms on file shall be eligible for review and consideration for an additional two years following initial submission. Nominators are encouraged to update application materials.
