The City of Moscow is upgrading its main sewer line. The city's contractor must dig a very large trench, and then place a new 36-inch line, connecting the treatment plant to existing sewer lines. The city completed portion of this upgrade a few years ago at the time Paradise Creek was realigned. This current phase of work extends from Stadium Drive, westward to the treatment plant. We've coordinated with campus users and the City to minimize the disruptions to activities on Wicks Field. The City's work is expected to last into September.

Paper Coauthored by Stephen Devadoss Receives Outstanding Paper Award

The paper, "Estimation of Consumers Willingness to Pay for Geographical Indication Banana Using Conjoint Analysis," coauthored by P.G. Dhamotharan, Stephen Devadoss and K.N. Selvaraj, was selected as the outstanding paper by the International Food Marketing Research Symposium, held in Budapest, Hungary June 19-21. As part of this award, this paper will be published in the Journal of Food Product Marketing. The work on this paper was conducted while Devadoss was on sabbatical at Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, India. P.G. Dhamotharan is a graduate student, and K.N. Selvaraj is a professor at Tamil Nadu Agricultural University.
