## Portfolio Requirements

Application to the Professional Architecture Program  
University of Idaho, College of Art and Architecture

All students who have completed the pre-professional program or equivalent and are applying for admission to the professional program must submit a portfolio of art, architectural graphics, and design work in a format **not larger than 8 ½ x 11**. The portfolio may contain up to ten pages (front and back = 20 pages) of original work or reproductions (**no slides or disks**). Examples of at least six (6) different projects from any of the required pre-professional program courses (i.e. ART 111, 121, or ARCH 154, 253, 254, and ART electives, or equivalents for transfer students) must be included. The remaining pages may be used to present projects of the student's choice. Students are encouraged to provide written explanations of projects within the context of the portfolio.

Submissions will be evaluated based on quality of the work and the presentation of the work through portfolio design.

(Optional) Applicants may include a one-page personal statement to explain any exceptional circumstances to be considered by the committee.
