

Bachelor of Fine Arts Review Required Criteria

You are eligible to apply for the professional B.F.A. program when you:

- Have completed the entire Art Core— Art 100, Art 110, Art 111, Art 112, Art 121, & Art 122 with a passing grade
- Have completed 15 credits of 200-level Art & Design studio courses with a passing grade
- Have a minimum Institutional 2.75 GPA

PLEASE NOTE: Student accepted must maintain a minimum Institutional GPA of 2.75 and receive a grade of C or better in all 300-400 level art courses. *Students accepted into the professional program must complete 15 credits of 300-level studio courses with at least 6 of the 15 credits in one sequential studio area and 6 credits of art history BEFORE registration in Art 490 and Art 495.*

Students may reapply for entry into the professional B.F.A. program twice or consider the Bachelor of Arts Degree.

- Digital Portfolio of 10 artworks and printed Image List.
 - Images can be submitted on CD or USB drive but must be compatible for Macs.
 - Images should be medium resolution JPEGs or PDFs of work done within the past 3 years
 - The Image List should include title, media, dimensions, and date of work. This list should be numbered to correspond with image files turned in.
 - Please put your name on the CD or USB drive.

* What is a “Statement of Intent?”

Write 1-3 concise paragraphs discussing your specific interests as they relate to your Art + Design focus. Include information about what you intend to do when you graduate. Are you considering graduate school? Do you want to work in a particular industry? Are you deciding between different directions? How will completing the B.F.A. program meet your educational and/or career goals?

Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be returned to the applicant without review. It is your responsibility to check your application and supporting materials thoroughly to be certain you have met all requirements.
