# **PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE THIRD YEAR PROFESSIONAL BACHELOR OF INTERIOR DESIGN PROGRAM UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO**

All students who have completed the Second Year Professional Program in Interior Design or equivalent and are applying for admission to the Third Year Professional Program must submit a portfolio of Interior Design, Architectural Graphics, art, and related design work in a format not larger than 8 ½" X 11". The portfolio may contain up to ten pages (front and back = 20 pages) of EXCELLENT QUALITY original work or reproductions (**no slides or disks**). Examples of at least six (6) different projects from any of the required program courses (i.e. ID 151, 152, ARCH 154, 253, ID 254, ART 110, 121, and electives, or equivalents for transfer students) must be included. Make sure that the overall portfolio speaks to interior design. You are encouraged to provide samples of your writing as well. The remaining pages may be used to present projects of the student's choice. Students are strongly encouraged to provide written explanations of projects within the context of the portfolio.

(Optional) You may include a one-page personal statement to explain any exceptional circumstances to be considered by the committee.

**Portfolio evaluation criteria: Please select your examples carefully and make sure that the medium used is appropriate and can be read easily. The Quality and representation of the following will be evaluated:**

- **Design Fundamentals:** Design elements; Design principles; Theories & history of design
- **Interior Design:** Conceptual/critical/creative thinking; Composition; Programming/user needs; Design process; Materiality; Design documentation
- **Visual Communication:** Drafting literacy/skills (hand and computer); Drawing skills; Attention to details; Execution
- **Overall:** Overall quality of portfolio; Ability to articulate design relationships; Developmental growth
