1. Review of minutes from last meeting:

The meeting convened at 8:05 a.m. Minutes of the September 9, 2010 meeting were reviewed, edited and accepted.

2. University Safety Committee update:

The committee meets today at 3:30. Items discussed at last meeting included: 1) focus on implementing the safety checklist items 1-7, developing laboratory emergency contact procedures, procedure for getting emergency evacuation maps installed in buildings, NetLearning@uidaho update, and update on vehicle use policy by Nancy Spink.

Gordon Murdoch requested assistance in getting eyewash stations repaired. The station has been out of service for 10 months 322 Ag Biotech. George said he would talk to Facilities Management about this issue.

3. Update on status NetLearning@uidaho

George provided an update on the system and encouraged to have employees view the new orientation training. This course is the basis for the overall safety orientation for all employees. Gordon Murdoch asked if the safety orientation would meet the NSF training requirement.

The next supervisor orientation class will be 11/17 at 10:30 in Admin 217.

Craig Robinson commented that there was a sound glitch in the last training webinar and George said he would follow-up to see if there was a recorded version available.

4. CALS accident report:

George reviewed accident report. There have been two accidents in the last month (horse related and bench grinder). Compared to last year CALS has 10 less incidents.

Tom Karsky suggested that a "to do" list be compiled and emailed to Holly Waters.

6. Safety Tip:

George provided a safety tip on eye protection. He reviewed the chart on eye and face protection and best practices on certain activities and what type of protective eye protection is recommended.

Donn Morishita had a question of stamp on eyeglasses. George shared that if approved eyewear by standards it will be stamped. George will put together a sheet on pesticide application safety and approved eyewear.

7. Miscellaneous

Tom Karsky mentioned that on the committee makeup Tom Koehler's name is spelled wrong.

It was suggested that Risk Management be invited to meeting to discuss vehicle use changes.
