Our topic is academic standing with probation status. When a student's Total Institutional Grade Point Average falls below a 2.00 the student is placed on Academic Probation.

The most commonly asked questions are:

Question: How will I know if I'm on academic probation?

Answer: You will receive an email from the Registrar's office stating that you have an important message in Vandal web.

Question: What can I expect after logging in to Vandal web?

Answer: You will have access to a detailed letter from the Registrar explaining what paper work must be completed. This includes an Academic Plan and a paper reflecting your performance from last term and new strategies to become more successful in the coming semester.

Question: My paperwork is done, what do I do now?

Answer: Contact the Advising Suite, 208-885-7141 to make an appointment to meet with one of the college's advisors.

Question: What other information should I know?

Answer: Students on probation have a "probation hold" placed on their Vandal Web account. Students will be unable to add, drop or change classes, until the Academic Plan and essay have been discussed with the student's advisor. At this meeting, the probation hold will be lifted. Probation is a serious matter and if not corrected in the next semester could lead to academic disqualification.
