- **1)** <u>General Core Studies</u> (J-3-d of General Catalog) Students must complete three different disciplines from the Humanities, Social Science, and International approved lists, and have one upper-division course, for a total of at least 18 credits. The Integrated Seminar does not count toward the three disciplines. Students take:
- a) An ISEM 101 Integrated Seminar (for 3 credits).
- b) Two **Humanities** courses (for 6 credits).
- c) Two **Social Sciences** courses (for 6 credits).
- d) An International course or experience (for 1-4 credits).
- e) **Additional Courses** (up to 9 additional credits). For total of 18 credits, select from approved capstone, humanities, social science or international courses.
- 2) Other Essential Core Requirements Students take:
- a) **Communication** courses (sections J-3-a of General Catalog). English 102 and one additional communication course for 5 credits.
- b) **Natural** and **Applied Sciences** courses (sections J-3-b of General Catalog). Sponsored by the College of Science, students select two science courses and labs, or an Integrated Science (CORS) course and one additional science course with a lab for 7-8 credits.
- C) Math, Statistics or Computer Science course (sections J-3-c of General Catalog). Sponsored by the College of Science, students take for 3-4 credits.
