## **Presentation and Repertoire Parameters**

Presentations and repertoire should focus on compositions and/or transcriptions of Johann Sebastian Bach and his contemporaries (composers actively writing during J.S. Bach's time), the Bach family, and other related topics with the preferred duration of twenty-five minutes or less.

**Application deadline**

Priority consideration will be given to proposals for lecture demonstrations, papers, panels, and performances postmarked on or before July 1, 2014. All applicants will be notified by August 1, 2014.
