Transfer students must have a minimum of four semesters of ensemble participation at the University of Idaho, at least two of which must be a major ensemble. **Major Ensembles:** MusA 116/316 Vandaleers, MusA 117/317 University Chorus, MusA 119/319 Marching Band, MusA 122/322 Orchestra, MusA 121/321 Concert Band, MusA 125/325 Symphonic Band, MusA 320 Wind Ensemble.
