Humanities: three credits (one course) in addition to the minimum university-wide requirements. Natural Sciences, Mathematics, and Statistics: six credits (two courses) in addition to the minimum university-wide requirements. Social Sciences: three credits (one course) in addition to the minimum university-wide requirements, or the successful completion of an academic minor, or an area of emphasis of at least 18 credits, which must be approved by the department in which the student is majoring.

A minimum of 128 credit hours (36 upper division) and an overall grade point average of 2.0 are required for graduation. In addition, a minimum of 70 credit hours must be outside the field of music.
