

Considerations for General Core Studies: Catalog 2012+
(SS = Social Science; H = Humanities; I = International)

Considering American Diversity (only need 3 cr):

Soc 101 Intro to Sociology is both a SS and American Diversity.

Anth 329 North American Indians is both a SS and American Diversity.

WmSt 201 Intro to Women Studies is both H and American Diversity.

AmSt 301 Studies in American Culture is both H and American Diversity (prereq Engl 102; Junior standing or permission).

Hist 315 Comparative African-American Cultures is both International and American Diversity.

Psyc 315 Psyc of Women is both an Upper Division Elective in Psyc and American Diversity (prereq Psyc 101).

Psyc 419 Adult Development and Aging is both an Upper Division Elective in Psyc and American Diversity (prereq Psyc 101).

Comm 432 Gender and Communication is both an Upper Division Elective in Psyc and American Diversity (prereq Comm 233 Interpersonal Communication).

Considering International (only need 3 cr):

Anth 220 Peoples of the World is both a SS and International.

Comm 335 Intercultural Communication is both a SS and International.
