

EDUCATION IS YOUR TICKET TO A BETTER JOB

- Students see their annual income increase, on average, by **\$192** for every credit completed at the University of Idaho.
- The average annual income of the typical bachelor's degree graduate in Idaho at the midpoint of his or her career is \$53,170, **97% more** than someone with a high school diploma.
- Over the course of a working lifetime, bachelor's degree graduates in Idaho earn \$1,021,292 more than someone with a high school diploma (undiscounted).

EDUCATION WILL PAY YOU BACK— FOR A LIFETIME

- Students enjoy an attractive 15.5% rate of return on their U-Idaho educational investment, and recover all costs (including wages given up while attending classes instead of working) in only 9.6 years.
- Over the course of his or her working career, the average U-ldaho student's lifetime earnings will increase **\$5.10** for every dollar invested in their U-ldaho education (in the form of tuition, fees, and foregone earnings).
