how to participate

Registration for trips is taken in person at the Outdoor Program office located in the Student Recreation Center. Each posted trip sheet lists specific information for that trip. Required pre-trip planning meetings are also indicated. Transportation and group equipment costs will be charged upon sign-up. Fees are non-refundable. Non-University of Idaho students may be charged an additional fee, which will be listed on sign-up sheets. Other activities are free or will have costs listed.
