



Service-Learning Reflection Leader (SLRL) Job Description



Qualifications:

- Interest in service-learning and civic engagement;
- Successful completion of a service-learning class preferred;
- Minimum GPA of 2.50;
- Willingness and ability to work effectively with faculty, students, and community partners;
- Enthusiasm for UI and our university's vision to engage every student in transformative lifelong learning.

Duties and Responsibilities:

(You will be assigned to one service-learning course)

- Attend and participate in 1 SL training session and monthly meetings
- Attend designated class meetings and service events
- Guide thought-provoking discussions about the students' service experiences and facilitate the reflection process as directed by the professor
- Assist professor as needed in peer mentoring, developing assignments, and/or conducting research
- Expected to work an average of 2 hours a week, not to exceed 30 hours total
- Serve as a liaison between the students, professors, and community partners
- Facilitate end of semester service-learning student course surveys
- Write a 2-page final reflection of your experience

Supervision:

Upon completion of your 2-hour SL training during the first week of classes, you will be assigned to a faculty member. He/she will direct and supervise your work, including a midterm and final performance evaluation.

Stipend:

\$250.00 payable at the end of the semester upon completion of your duties and responsibilities
