All insurance waivers are audited each semester and MUST MEET the requirements below to qualify for a waiver:

- 1. Be valid health insurance (cost sharing or medical discount programs DO NOT qualify for a waiver).
- 2. Effective on or before the first day of the semester waiver is requested.
- 3. Continuous and verifiable for the entire semester (no termination or break).
- 4. Cover both illness and injury.
- 5. Have a lifetime maximum of at least \$500,000.
- 6. Cover injury while participating in intramural, club, or NCAA intercollegiate sports programs (if student is participating in such programs).

If submitted insurance does not meet the requirements above final acceptance of a SHIP waiver will not be granted. Waiver status notifications are sent to the student's official Vandal email account. Student will be enrolled in SHIP for each semester of attendance. The charge for medical insurance will be placed on the student account. The Student Financial Aid Office and Student Accounts Office can assist with financial questions and payment arrangements.
