In order to participate in VandaLink, CSI students must successfully complete an associate degree (AA, AS, or AE) from CSI and identify their desire to transfer to University of Idaho to continue their education. CSI students may join the VandaLink program at any point in their CSI career, but no later than the term that they earn 45 degree applicable credits.
