In order to participate in VandaLink, NIC students must successfully complete an associate degree (AA or AS) from NIC and identify their desire to transfer to University of Idaho to continue their education. NIC students may join the VandaLink program at any point in their NIC career, but no later than the term that they earn 45 degree applicable credits.
