Student Services

Parking, Bus & Transportation

Parking in the courthouse corridor is free for the first hour and \$1.00 per every additional hour. Full-time students are eligible for free bus passes. Bus passes are issued with Vandal cards or you can pick one up through U of I Boise Operations in Suite 324. Parking validation stickers can be purchased through the on site parking office at a reduced rate.

Building Safety

Vandal Cards

Your Vandal Card is your official U of I identification card. If you have assigned work space in the IWC or are a Law student, you will need a Vandal Card for appropriate building access. Please submit a [Vandal Card request](#) through the ITS portal. Please make sure you follow the photo requirements listed on this link before proceeding on to the “Request a Vandal Card” form.

If you are a student with an assigned work area, you will be contacted during the card creation process by a member of the U of I Boise Operations team to confirm what building access you should be granted. Please be prepared with contact information for your supervisor or academic advisor to approve your building access.

Please note: Due to complications arising from the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic, card creation may have longer than usual wait times. A member of the U of I Boise Operations team will contact you at your Vandal e-mail when your card is ready to be picked up.

COVID-19 Updates
