Featured countries are United States, Mexico, Russia, Kenya, Greece, and Japan.</li> <li>Each of the six units includes five activities based on a single culture, a featured book, and a food group from ChooseMyPlate.gov. Each unit includes the following activities: reading, nutrition, cooking, physical activity, cultural experience and take-home activity. The Family Take-home sheet provides nutritional information, activities and recipes for families to do at home. Family Take-home sheets are also available in Spanish.</li> <li>Most books may be easily borrowed from a local library.
