* Meets U of I General Education Requirements. Students must complete 36 General Education credits. Students can adjust when to take these courses depending on their scores from the ACT, SAT and other standardized assessments. (H), (I), (AD) and (Capstone) indicate that the course fulfills general education requirements for the humanities, international studies, American diversity and Capstone, respectively.

**IAD students can take Art 112 in the second year of the program or per advisor suggestion.

*** Students must take BOTH Arch 385 and Arch 386 to obtain a minor in architecture. If a minor in architecture is not pursued, only one of these courses counts toward major credits.

A "C" or above is required for successful completion of all IAD studio courses.

Students who begin their college studies at the U of I must complete the U of I Core requirements for the catalog year in which they were admitted.

Co-ops and internships are strongly advised. Study abroad and other minors and certificates are also encouraged with advisor consultation.
