### Celebrating the Contributions of Black, Indigenous and Women of Color to the Women's Movement

## Call for Submissions

This fall, the Women's Center is celebrating 50 years of working for gender equity on campus and in our community, and we're inviting University of Idaho students to be part of the commemorative events honoring this momentous milestone! We are planning to install a circular timeline in the ISUB Rotunda, honoring the contributions of Black, Indigenous and Women of Color (BIWOC) to the Women's Rights' Movement.

We are seeking artistic, creative, and other types of submissions for display that honor the work and legacy of BIWOC communities' contributions to feminism. You may choose to highlight an individual, group, or event of significance in the history of feminism. We welcome submissions of original pieces in any medium, including painting and drawing, printing, collage, sculpture, textile arts, etc. Digital works such as videos may also be accepted—please check with the Women's Center regarding logistics for display.

Work selected for display must be submitted with a title and accompanying artist statement (max. 100 words), as well as a brief paragraph describing the subject(s) of the artwork and the date range of their activism or contributions to the women's rights movement.

Artwork will be installed in the ISUB Rotunda during the last week of September and first week of October. Visitors will be given the opportunity to vote for three People's Choice awards. Winning artists will receive a cash prize, and their work will be displayed at our keynote event and featured in advertising for the Women's Center's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary events. **Please note, only original content created without copyright infringement will be accepted.** 

Eligibility: All University of Idaho degree-seeking undergraduate, graduate, and professional students enrolled for the Fall 2022 semester at any U of I location are invited to enter. No more than one entry per student will be accepted. Students must complete and submit the attached submission form and student permission form along with their art piece.

Entries must be delivered to the Women's Center anytime on Monday to Friday, between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm, no later than September 19, 2022. Images for display on a standing easel must be framed or mounted on laminated foam core or stiff cardstock. Other types of submissions may be displayed on tables or pedestals, depending on size or weight.
