<p><b>Youth Materials:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>4-H Potato Grower Workbook (#73119)</i> 📖2004</li> <li>• <i>4-H Potato Project and Record Book (#73119a)</i></li> <li>• <i>ZSuites 4-H Involvement Report</i></li> </ul> <p><b>Volunteer Materials:</b></p> <p><i>None</i></p>	<p>Project Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Own your project with a bonafide agreement with your parent or landlord covering machinery, labor, seed, share, etc. This must be signed by your parent and Volunteer.</li> <li>• Supply a legal description of land where you grow potatoes.</li> <li>• Complete a pesticide report.</li> <li>• Attend the annual field tour of potato projects and give an oral presentation on cultural practices (what it takes to produce the crop) during the tour.</li> <li>• Deliver approximately 1,000 hundred (cwt) of potatoes to purchaser.</li> <li>• Watch your samples being graded by the USDA.
