



## 2020 Summer AmeriCorps Position Announcement

4-H Summer AmeriCorps Instructor at Payette County, Gooding County, Kootenai County, Canyon County, Ada County, Boundary County, Bonneville County, Bingham County, and the Discovery Center of Idaho located in Boise.

Idaho 4-H Youth Development is seeking applicants to serve as a 4-H AmeriCorps Instructor in various locations throughout the state of Idaho, to serve 450 hours from May 18-August 14, 2020.

AmeriCorps is a national service opportunity for those aged 17 and older who come from various social, cultural, economic, and educational backgrounds. AmeriCorps Members commit their time and talents to address critical community needs such as: increasing academic achievement, mentoring youth, poverty, sustaining national parks, and preparing for disasters.

4-H AmeriCorps Instructors will teach, lead, and facilitate STEAM, Leadership, Civic Engagement, or Healthy Living curriculum in an out-of-school time setting throughout the summer. Instructors will also help develop partnerships with local organizations and help recruit volunteers. 4-H AmeriCorps Instructors serve as mentors and role models, teach important life skills, and give youth positive opportunities to explore the world around them in a fun, engaging, non-formal learning environment. Summer Instructors will serve approximately 40 hours a week over the course of 12-13 weeks for a minimum of 450 hours. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and willing to undergo a criminal history check.

Summer AmeriCorps Instructors receive the following benefits:

- Living Allowance of \$3,150 paid out in 7 increments over the summer
- Segal Education Award of \$1,612 to be used on past or future educational expenses. Education Awards are released after successful completion of service hours
- Significant hands on learning experience
- Professional development opportunities
