Quick Reference Guide*

A Creative Commons License is a way for authors to provide copyright permissions to others in a simple, standardized way. This quick reference guide is a way for you to identify if you can use a work and what the terms of use are.

License Symbols	Abbreviation	License Name	Description
Ø	CC O	Public Domain	Can use however you want with no attribution.
$\bigcirc \textcircled{1}$	CC BY	Attribution	Can use and adapt as long as you give credit.
\odot	CC BY-SA	Attribution- ShareAlike	Can use and adapt as long as you give credit. Must attach the same license.
	CC BY-ND	Attribution- NoDerivs	Can use, but cannot adapt the material and must give appropriate credit.
	CC BY-NC	Attribution- NonCommercial	Can use and adapt with credit, but <u>not for</u> <u>commercial</u> use.
\odot	CC BY-NC-SA	Attribution- NonCommercial- ShareAlike	Can use and adapt with credit, but <u>not for</u> <u>commercial</u> use. Must attach same license.
\odot	CC BY-NC-ND	Attribution- NonCommercial- NoDerivs	Can use, but cannot adapt the material and must give credit. <u>Cannot use for commercial purposes</u> .
