

# MG LANDSCAPE DESIGN ASSIGNMENT

Due February 14<sup>th</sup>

- 1) **Site analysis:** Measure the site and sketch it out on graph paper, adding labels for what is there now. Show the scale you are using (ex:  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch = 1 foot). Label North with an arrow and the letter "N." Use pencil to start but darken the lines later with a pen or marker. Save this site analysis to use on #2 below.
- 2) **Rough designs:** Place a piece of tracing paper (or any paper that you can see your lines through) on top of your dark-lined site analysis and start having fun. Experiment with different ideas and placement of items and plants. Make at least 2-3 versions of possibilities for your design. Once again, start with pencil but later darken the rough designs so they are more readable. Choose one of these "play" ideas as a basis for your final design. Save all the rough designs to turn in later.
