

MG LANDSCAPE DESIGN ASSIGNMENT

Part 2

- 1) **Final design:** Choose one of your “play” ideas/rough designs and now draw it on a new sheet of graph paper with all the plants and other features labeled and colored in. Indicate North with an arrow and note the scale used (ex: 2 squares = 1 foot). Letter, number or color-code the plants in some way. The labeling system for the plants should be listed on a separate piece of paper as well. Use pens, markers, colored pencils, crayons or paints to accent this final drawing. Save this drawing to turn in.
- 2) **Plant list:** Create a list of the plants used in your plan and their corresponding letter, number or color. Catalog the plants you are using in this way:
 - a. common and scientific name of each plant
 - b. mature height and width
 - c. color of flowers, berries or fall leaf color
 - d. how many of each plant used in your final plan
 - e. include pictures of the plants - pictures can be obtained from nursery catalogs or online.

Make sure your name is on each piece of paper.

Note: All together you will be turning in a total of 6 items to complete this assignment.

- a final design
- a plant list with pictures
- 3 play ideas
- a site analysis
