

# 2021 Canyon County 4-H/FFA Market Livestock

Canyon County Fair  
July 29-August 1, 2021

Youth may sell one market animal per year at one Fair (either Ada or Canyon) regardless of which county they are enrolled in 4-H or FFA. Participants may weigh-in or declare market animals at initial weigh-in for only one county Fair (Ada or Canyon).

All market animals must be initially weighed in or identified/tagged with the county where they are going to enter, show and sell. If you are going to show an animal in Canyon County it must be weighed in at the Canyon County initial weigh-in or identified/tagged by species deadline. If you are going to show an animal in Ada County, it must be weighed in at the Ada County initial weigh-in. All individual market animals can only be tagged, weighed and shown in one (1) county.

## ALL MARKET ANIMALS:

- ◆ Market Animal Declaration form is required and will be collected at initial weigh-in or declaration date for all market animals
  - Form can be found at <http://www.uidaho.edu/extension/county/canyon/4-h>
  - Animals that do not make the minimum weight requirement at final weigh-in may be entered in the feeder class or taken home
  - Decision to take home must be made immediately after weigh-in
- ◆ Mortality insurance fee will be collected at initial weigh-in or declaration deadline. It will be collected on the first animal weighed in each species.
- ◆ All animals selling at the Market Animal Sale on July 31, 2021 will be sold by the HEAD (not by the pound). Market Broilers will be sold as a pen of three (3).
- ◆ Make all checks payable to [Canyon County Market Livestock Sale or CCMLS](#).
- ◆ **NOTE: Each exhibitor may sell only one (1) market animal (or broiler pen) of any species.**

## BEEF

- ◇ Limit 2 market head at Fair
- ◇ Submit a Market Animal Declaration form at weigh-in; weigh-in fees: **\$25 first head** (Insurance \$15, Sale Admin \$5, Judge \$4, Vet/Online entries \$1), **\$10 per additional head** (Sale Admin \$5, Judge \$4, Vet/Online entries \$1)
- ◇ Initial Weigh-in: **Saturday, March 6** from **9am-11am** at Treasure Valley Livestock Auction
  - Recommended target weight: 775-875 lbs.
  - Steers should be halter broke and must be de-horned
- ◇ Final Weigh-in: **Tuesday, July 27** at Canyon County Fairgrounds (Health check at stalls 5:30-7:30 pm; Weigh-in 7:00-8:00 pm)
  - Final minimum weight to sell at Canyon County Fair: 1050 lbs. (143 day feed period)

## SWINE

- ◇ Limit 2 market head at Fair
- ◇ Ear tags available on Friday, March 12 (maximum 3 head tagged/youth)
- ◇ Submit a Market Animal Declaration form and the fee of **\$15 first head** (Insurance \$5, Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1), **\$10 per additional head** (Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1) **no later than Tuesday, April 13, 2021; 5 pm to the Canyon County Extension Office** (501 Main St. Caldwell)
  - Recommended target weight: 75-90 lbs.
- ◇ Market Animal Declaration form must include ear tag number, breed, gender, detailed description of animal and at least one (1) picture attached of the pig with the ear tag number showing (over back to show breed/color)
- ◇ Final Weigh-in: **Wednesday, July 28** from **6am-9am** at Canyon County Fairgrounds
  - Final minimum weight to sell at Canyon County Fair: 220 lbs. (105 day feed period)

## SHEEP

- ◇ Limit 2 market head at Fair
- ◇ Submit a Market Animal Declaration form and the fee of **\$15 first head** (Insurance \$5, Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1), **\$10 per additional head** (Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1) **no later than Tuesday, May 11, 2021; 5 pm to the Canyon County Extension Office** (501 Main St. Caldwell)
  - Recommended target weight: 60-70 lbs.
  - Scrapies tags are required for all ewes
  - It is highly recommended that the tail be docked at the distal end of the caudal fold in accordance with AVMA guidelines. Lambs exhibiting evidence of surgically removed tail will not be allowed.
- ◇ Market Animal Declaration form must include ear tag number, breed, gender, detailed description of animal and at least one (1) picture attached of the animal with the ear tag number showing
- ◇ Final Weigh-in: **Wednesday, July 28** from **5pm-8pm** at Canyon County Fairgrounds
  - Final minimum weight to sell at Canyon County Fair: 110 lbs. (77 day feed period)

## MARKET GOAT

- ◇ Limit 2 market head at Fair
- ◇ Submit a Market Animal Declaration form and the fee of **\$15 first head** (Insurance \$5, Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1), **\$10 per additional head** (Sale Admin \$3, Judge \$6, Vet/Online entries \$1) **no later than Tuesday, May 11, 2021; 5 pm to the Canyon County Extension Office** (501 Main St. Caldwell)
  - Recommended target weight: 30-40 lbs. (Born after January 1, 2021)
  - Scrapies tags or tattoo required for all does
- ◇ Market Animal Declaration form must include ear tag number, breed, gender, detailed description of animal and at least one (1) picture attached of the animal with the ear tag number showing
- ◇ Final Weigh-in: **Wednesday, July 28** from **5pm-8pm** at Canyon County Fairgrounds
  - Final minimum weight to sell at Canyon County Fair: 65 lbs. (77 day feed period)

## MARKET BROILER

- ◇ Limit one market pen of 3 at Fair *and an additional showmanship bird*
- ◇ Required Intent to Participate form due **Monday, April 28, 2021** by 5 pm to the Canyon County Extension Office
- ◇ Must have a minimum of 5-10 white Cornish-Cross breed chicks hatched between May 9-15, 2021
- ◇ Chicks ordered with the Intent to Participate forms will be picked up on **Wednesday, May 12, 2021** from **4-6 pm** at the Canyon County Extension Office
- ◇ Market Animal Declaration form, **\$4 for pen of 3** (Sale Admin \$3, Vet/Online entries \$1), and proof of purchase (must include birthdate and breed) due to the Canyon County Extension Office by **Wednesday, May 19, 2021**
- ◇ Final Weigh-in: **Wednesday, July 21** from **5pm-6pm** at Canyon County Fairgrounds
  - Final minimum weight to sell at Canyon County Fair: 7 lbs./bird
