

# Western Idaho Fair August 18-28, 2022

## 4-H/FFA Market Livestock Weigh-In Schedule

*Final as of 02-02-2022*

All animals must be initially weighed in at the county where they are going to enter, show and sell. If you are going to show an animal in Canyon County it must be weighed in at the Canyon County initial weigh-in. If you are going to show an animal in Ada County it must be weighed in at the Ada County initial weigh-in. All market animals can only be tagged, weighed and shown in one (1) county. Ada County Beef weigh-in is combined with the Canyon County weigh-in. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know which beef is going to what fair at the unloading check point where animals will be marked accordingly.

### FINAL WEIGH-IN

<b>Beef</b>	Thursday August 18, 2022 4:00 to 5:00 pm Western Idaho Fairgrounds At Digital Scales	1,000 lbs. Minimum
<b>Swine</b>	Thursday August 18, 2022 7:30 to 9:00 pm Western Idaho Fairgrounds At Digital Scales	230 lbs. Minimum 300 lbs. Maximum 301-320 lbs. Maximum **
<b>Sheep</b>	Thursday August 18, 2022 5:30 to 7:30 pm Western Idaho Fairgrounds At Small Scales	110 lbs. Minimum (Lambs that prolapsed will not be allowed on grounds or to sell.)
<b>Market Goats</b>	Thursday August 18, 2022 5:30 to 7:30 pm Western Idaho Fairgrounds At Small Scales	65 lbs. Minimum

- \*ADG (average daily gain), from University of Idaho 4-H Animal Science lesson plans, are used to calculate the target weights.
- Animals brought to fair **must** be on your entry form, you may enter all animals from initial weigh in, but **only** bring 2 to fair.
- Animals not meeting weight requirements will not sell. But can be shown in the feeder class  
Note: Each exhibitor can sell only one (1) market animal of any market species.
- Animals who do not make minimum weights may be taken home the night of entry.
- \*\* Swine weighing between 301-320 will only be allowed to sell if the sale committee can find a buyer for these heavy weight swine.
- It is recommended that the sheep tail be docked at the distal end of the caudal fold in accordance with the AVMA guidelines.
- If the sales clerk does not have COOL forms (Sheep and Goats) or Feed Affidavits (beef) on file when needed you will **NOT** sell.

**Entry Deadline for WIF is August 1, 2022**

**Remember that NO LATE or INCOMPLETE ENTRIES will be ACCEPTED!**
