- Include one close-up picture
- Include one entire plant picture
- Include one picture showing plant and surrounding landscape
- Additional pictures can be included as needed







## Insect Photo Submission Guide

- Use as much magnification as possible
- Take several photographs: Different angles, magnification, upper & lower surfaces
- Include a size reference
- Identify plant affected by insect, include picture if plant is unknown
- How to Take Better Photos of Insects for Identification
