Attend six club meetings.</li> <li>3. Complete at least 5 new items from the Archery Skill Checklist each year.</li> <li>4. Give an oral presentation (speech, demonstration or illustrated talk) related to this project.</li> <li>5. Complete 2 activities from the STEM Connections workbook each year; list the activities completed in the Project Activity Page of your Record Book</li> <li>6. Complete the ZSuites record book.</li> </ol>	<p><b>All levels:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Completed 4-H ZSuites Record Book <b>AND</b></li> <li>2. A <b>small (40x28) trifold</b>. 1/3 of the trifold is to be about the youth and 2/3 is to be about the archery project <b>AND</b></li> <li>3. Archery Skills Checklist</li> <li>4. Plus, the level appropriate activity listed below:</li> </ol> <p><b>Level I</b> Trifold as per instructions above.</p> <p><b>Level II</b> Fletch 6 arrows. Display the best 3 with your trifold.</p> <p><b>Level III</b> Make something archery related to display with your trifold.</p> <p><b>Level IV</b> Choose either the Level II or Level III category and develop that subject on an advanced level, (4<sup>th</sup> year and above), and display with your trifold.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> For safety reasons, exhibits cannot include live ammunition, broadheads, knives or functional firearms.</p>
