

Oil Painting Requirements: Unit III

PURPOSE:

1. To learn to see colors and shapes. "If you can see it you can draw or paint it." So it is important to observe and train your mind and eyes to see everything in detail. The goal this year is to paint directly from nature outside.

REQUIREMENTS UNIT III:

1. Learn about framers, make a framer and use it.
2. Sketch, and paint two oil paintings of outdoor scenes no larger than 18"x24".
3. Learn about complimentary colors and hues.
4. Add colors to color wheel.
5. Visit an art show, art museum, or go to the library and make a study of different artists and art in the oil medium.

EXHIBIT:

1. Display your framed oil painting no larger than 18"x24" that has been painted outside.
2. Display your framer and color wheel.
3. Completed ZSuite 4-H Project Record Book.
4. Your 8½" X 11" sketches of pictures you painted.
