Jerry Guinn was a leader and a teacher. He loved to share his knowledge with youth and was a pioneer in the construction industry. With only an eighth grade education, Jerry was still able to achieve financial success and he firmly believed that “being born poor, being born in a broken home, being abused, or having a so-called ‘bad childhood’ is NOT an excuse.” He lived what he preached and that was “if you want something, it is up to YOU to achieve it!” Jerry left this earth in December of 2004 to begin a new, eternal journey.
