What is it? This is a combined demonstration & public speaking contest with contests for job interviews, extemporaneous speaking, dramatic readings, and TV commercials.

Who can participate? Any enrolled 2019 Gem/Boise County or Valley County 4-H member.

Categories:

- Score sheets for the contests listed below are available through the Gem County Extension Office. (Job Interview Score Sheets are the exception.)
- Demonstrations & Illustrated Talks – Livestock & Small Animals, Home Economics & Miscellaneous, and Horse. No live animals, please.
- Prepared Speeches – for all members, not just those with Public Speaking projects!
- Extemporaneous Speeches – Members will randomly draw the topic they need to speak on 10 minutes prior to judging. Topic will be age-appropriate. They will then speak 3-5 minutes on that topic.
- TV Commercial Contest - This prepared commercial is to be a 30- 90 second “ad” selling a product never before seen. Have props, etc. for this is designed to be for TV rather than radio. The same guidelines will apply for the team commercial category. These will be videotaped for future enjoyment! Grab a friend to enter!
- Interview Contest – Juniors need to bring one copy of a “resume” to the contest; Intermediates add a cover letter, and Seniors should add a cover letter and letter of recommendation. See the rules for type of job each age category will be applying for.
- Dramatic Reading Oral Presentation. Words and actions are used to present material to either entertain or educate. Presenter may write own material or use published material. A copy of written material must be provided to Judge(s) during contest. Costume, make-up or props are required. Score sheets available at Gem County Extension.

Certificates and awards ceremony will take place after all presentations are given. Start planning now to participate in several of these contests.
