No scholarship or award may be assigned to another person by the recipient. Scholarships and awards must be used during the year they are awarded unless approved by council otherwise. The year in this instance is considered to be one year from date awarded. The amount awarded will not exceed the amount requested. See application for due date. Scholarship recipients will be selected by the Leaders Council members present at a regular scheduled Year End Awards Committee meeting. This committee shall meet prior to September 15<sup>th</sup> per Gem/Boise Leaders Council bylaws.

For scholarships not based on contests a scholarship application is available at the Extension Office. The number of scholarships and money designated may change from year to year-

## RECOGNITION NIGHT SCHOLARSHIPS

Three \$100 scholarships may be awarded at Recognition Night for teens who have demonstrated excellence in project work, leadership and 4-H citizenship nominated by leader(s). These scholarships are to be used within one year to attend 4-H function, event, or activity. The following scholarships are awarded and sponsored by Gem/Boise Leaders Council if funding is available.

**4-H Leadership Scholarship** - A \$100 Scholarship is presented at Recognition Night to a 4-H teen who has demonstrated leadership growth in a Teen Leadership project on the local, club, county, district, and state level.

**4-H Livestock Scholarship** – A \$100 Scholarship is presented at Recognition Night to a 4-H teen who has demonstrated excellence in a livestock project.

**4-H Citizenship Scholarship** - A \$100 Scholarship is presented at Recognition Night to a 4-H teen who has demonstrated leadership and growth in the areas of community pride and/or international exchange projects.
